All major aspects of liver disease and recent clinical and basic science findings will be addressed.

The issues addressed, as well as the rational for the needs of the educational programme, are separated below for each of the disease tracks defined by EASL.

Key sessions:

One day courses:

Postgraduate course: Lifestyle and the liver

Basic science seminar: Artificial intelligence and omics data in hepatology

State of the Art lecture:

General Hepatology

Key issues addressed

- 1. Advances in Basic Science and Regenerative Medicine
- 2. Application of computer science in hepatology: role of big data processing for integrating omics data, and artificial intelligence for improving disease risk stratification and image interpretation
- 3. Update on immunological liver diseases and liver transplantation
- 4. Update on the most significant advances relevant to all hepatologists during the last year

The General Hepatology track will provide an update on the new advancements in Basic Research and Regenerative Medicine, and on the application of Computer Science (big data processing and artificial intelligence) to the characterization of biological processes and disease risk stratification that have been rendered possible by recent technological breakthroughs.

It will also provide an update on immunological liver disease and liver transplantation (not covered by other tracks), and on the most important novelties emerged during the last year that are relevant to all hepatologists.

Metabolic, alcohol and toxicity

Key issues addressed

- 1. Role of lifestyle in the pathogenesis of liver disease obesity and excess alcohol main aetiological factors
- 2. New screening and case-finding strategies for liver disease in the population and novel biomarkers
- 3. Emerging mechanisms of disease, including the role of gutliver axis and inflammatory pathways
- 4. Advancements in the development of new treatments and therapeutic approaches for non-alcoholic fatty liver disease

Increased fat in the liver (fatty liver) is becoming the leading cause of liver disease worldwide, and prevalence is on the rise, posing a threat to public health. Risk factors include excess calories and alcohol, low physical activity and obesity and the presence of comorbidities such as diabetes and hypertension. Alterations in the gutliver axis and inherited factors play a role in the pathogenesis.

Urgent unmet needs include: development of optimal approaches to improve lifestyle and prevent disease development and progression, strategies to identify individuals at risk at the general population level, novel more accurate non-invasive biomarkers of liver damage, and pharmacological treatments to delay or reverse disease progression.

Cirrhosis and complications

Key issues addressed

- 1. Liver vessels changes as drivers of liver disease progression
- 2. Management of ascites acute kidney and its complications
- 3. Management of oesophageal varices in 2021
- 4. New challenges in the management of vascular liver diseases

ILC 2021 will present an overview of the role of vessels in liver diseases. It includes the role of liver sinusoidal changes in liver disease progression, but also the management of portal and hepatic vein thrombosis and their complications.

Management of complications of portal hypertension in 2021 will also be addressed, including management of refractory ascites, bacterial infection, acute kidney injury and variceal bleeding.

Cholestasis and autoimmune

Cholestasis can arise as a consequence of hepatocyte dysfunction, biliary defects, or autoimmune dysregulation. Cholestatic liver disease also results in other symptoms, which must be handled by the hepatologist. This track therefore encompasses clinical considerations from itch and fatigue to bone and skin disorders in cholestasis, which are addressed in a Board and a Meet the experts session, allowing interactions between physicians to discuss how best to handle these cases. A pros and cons session will also address whether or not to use Fxr agonists in cholangiopathies, while a Grand Rounds session will tackle the discussion of how to manage patients with sclerosing cholangitis.

In order to develop therapies or cures, a deeper understanding of the genetic and cellular mechanisms leading to cholestasis is needed; and will be the focus of both a Symposium and a Meet the Experts sessions.

By addressing these basic and clinical points, this track aims to highlight the most recent developments in clinical practice and the state of the art for basic research.

Viral Hepatitis

Key issues addressed

- 1. The pipeline to cure chronic hepatitis B
- 2. The road towards global HCV elimination
- 3. New treatment options for chronic hepatitis D are on the horizon
- 4. Understanding the pathogenesis of hepatitis E virus infection and developing concepts to cure chronic hepatitis E

Viral hepatitis is a major cause of chronic liver disease. Infections with hepatitis B, C, D and E viruses can lead to chronic viral hepatitis and hepatocellular carcinoma. Treatment options for chronic viral hepatitis have evolved in recent years. Chronic hepatitis C can now be cured in almost all patients. Therefore, the new goal and the new focus is the global elimination of HCV. Chronic hepatitis B can be controlled by antiviral agents, but new drugs targeting HBV are under development to achieve the new goal "HBV Cure". Chronic hepatitis D is the most aggressive form and the treatment options have been very limited so far. New treatment options are now close to approval.

These new therapeutic developments are currently the focus of chronic hepatitis B and D. Hepatitis E is the most common acute viral hepatitis, and chronic cases are limited to immunodeficient individuals. Other interesting aspects of this infection emerge, e.g. extrahepatic manifestations. Therefore, the focus is on understanding virology and developing treatment concepts.

Liver tumours

Key issues addressed

- 1. Knowledge in the liver carcinogenesis mechanisms is growing
- 2. Radiology and pathology tools for liver cancer diagnosis
- 3. Management of special populations
- 4. Immunotherapy in liver cancer

The liver cancer field is under incredible changes due to the epidemiology modification of the liver diseases after the HCV cure with DAA, the increase of metabolic diseases and the more interest in rare tumours. All these factors are also linked with the better understanding of liver carcinogenesis mechanism related to immunity and potential role of new diagnostic tools. This is key for the improvement in the diagnosis and staging.

The absence of positive clinical trials beyond drugs related to angiogenesis in the systemic treatment field reflects the need to refine the understanding of the evolutionary paths of the patients and the stratification of patients according to novel parameters. This should be a major aim of the EASL community and of the physicians dealing with cancer patients along the different stages. This is also precision medicine.

In addition, tumours different from HCC such as cholangiocarcinoma or hemangioendotelioma are other areas with very active evolution that we also consider in the ILC 2021.

THE VENUE
