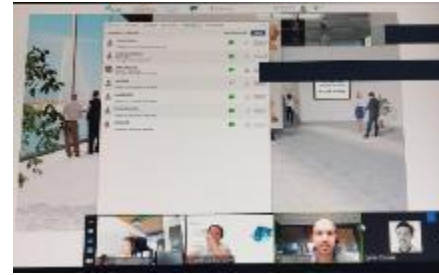

Airports

Enhanced cleaning

All 6 London airports offer enhanced cleaning of key touchpoints and hand sanitiser stations.

Additional measures in some airports include:

- **Antibacterial coatings** with an active working life of up to 6 months
- **Body temperature checks**
- **On-site Covid-19 testing centre** for passengers
- **UV light cleaning** on escalator handrails and in toilet facilities
- **Testing of areas** to monitor the performance of all cleaning measures in place

Face Coverings - mandatory for all airport staff and passengers aged 11 or older.

Touchless and contactless experience – contactless payments and screens at check-in desks and shops

Social Distancing - Signs, public announcements, and floor stickers

Public Transport - TfL

Enhanced cleaning

Used across the transport network:

- Long-lasting hospital-grade cleaning subproducts
- More frequent cleaning throughout the day of high-touch areas
- 200 UV light devices are continually sanitising escalator handrails

Cleaning testing - Imperial College RNA sampling study. None of the tests have found any traces of the virus

Hand sanitiser stations – over 1,000 installed across the network

Face Coverings – mandatory

Contactless payments – use of Oyster card or contactless payment card to travel.

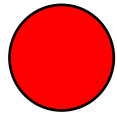
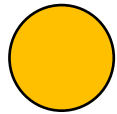
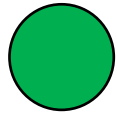

Red	Yes	PCR test on/before day 2 and day 8 on return to the UK	Yes – 10 days of quarantine at designated hotel. Package booked before departure.

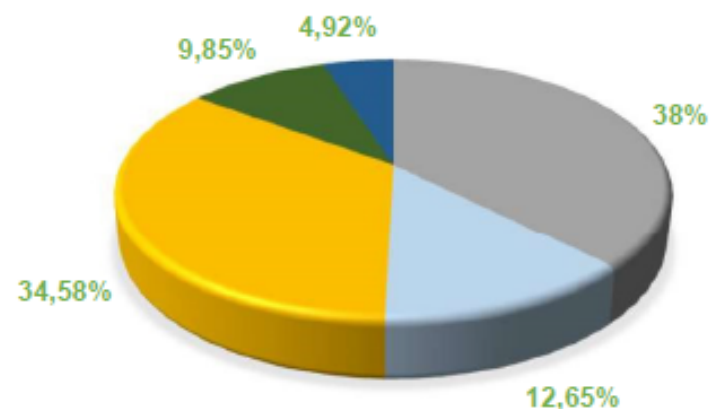

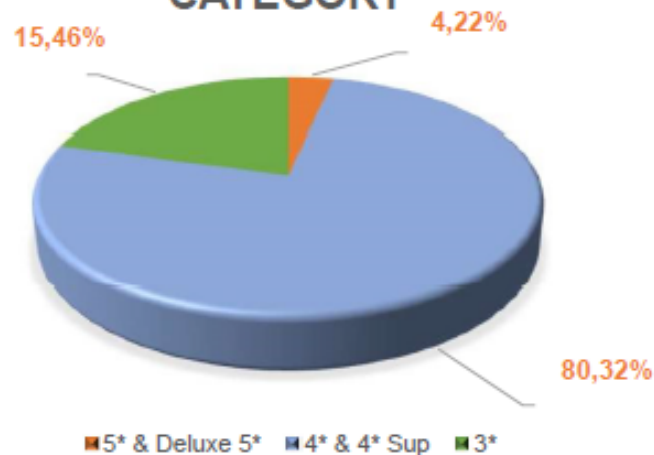
