



Sven Francque

Prof. Sven Francque is a leading expert in gastroenterology and hepatology, specializing in non-alcoholic fatty liver disease (NAFLD) and non-alcoholic steatohepatitis (NASH).

He earned his MD from the University of Antwerp and completed training in Belgium and France. Prof. Francque received his PhD in 2011, focusing on vascular changes in steatosis. He has authored over 180 papers and book chapters and serves as an editor for JHep Reports.

Currently, he is the chairman of the Department of Gastroenterology and Hepatology at the University Hospital Antwerp and a senior professor at the University of Antwerp.


He is also a key figure in Belgian gastroenterology, coordinating national NAFLD guidelines and the Belgian Week of Gastroenterology.

Mads Israelsen

Mads Israelsen, MD, PhD, is an Associate Professor at the Odense Liver Research Center, Odense University Hospital, Denmark.

His research mainly focuses on the overlap between the metabolic dysfunction-driven and alcohol-driven liver disease, particularly MetALD.

He was the principal investigator of the GALA-RIF trial, published in The Lancet Gastroenterology & Hepatology.

Prof. Israelsen has contributed to understanding the clinical impact of steatotic liver disease (SLD) and its influence on patient management and clinical trial design.

He is also a co-author of the Lancet Seminar on SLD, helping shape global perspectives on the disease.

Dr. Mohammed Y. Alghamdi, MD, FRCPC, is a consultant in internal medicine, gastroenterology, hepatology, and liver transplantation.

He has served as the past president of the Saudi Association for the Study of Liver Diseases and Transplantation (SASLT) and the GI Scientific Committee at the Saudi Commission for Health Specialties.

Currently, he is the Executive Director of Training at the Saudi Council for Health Specialties and Chief of Physicians at the King Fahd Military Complex in Dhahran, Saudi Arabia.

Dr. Mohamed Y. Alghamdi holds board certifications in internal medicine and gastroenterology from both the American and Canadian boards.


He completed his fellowship in Hepatology and Liver Transplantation at the University of Western Ontario, Canada.



Jérôme Boursier

Dr. Jérôme Boursier (MD, PhD) is a Professor of Medicine at Angers University and Head of the Hepato-Gastroenterology Department at Angers University Hospital.

He earned his medical degree in 2006 and completed his PhD in 2011, focusing on non-invasive diagnosis of liver fibrosis in chronic hepatitis C.

He furthered his research with a fellowship at Duke University in 2014, studying gut microbiota and MASLD.

Dr. Boursier leads the HIFIH Lab at Angers University and serves as the General Secretary of the French Association for the Study of the Liver.


He has authored over 200 papers and delivered over 150 lectures internationally.

William Alazawi is Professor of Hepatology at Queen Mary University London where he leads an MRC-funded translational liver research group that focuses on mechanisms in Steatotic Liver Disease and understanding the risk factors for progression.

He is the co-lead for the Clinical Academic Training School and Director of Research at the Blizard Institute.

He is a Consultant Hepatologist and the interim Clinical Director in Specialist Medicine at The Royal London Hospital, where he also leads the MASLD and One-Stop Diagnostic Liver Services.


